OATA Return to Play Document

The Section reviewed the OATA draft for *Guidelines For Making Return To Play Decisions By An Ohio Licensed Athletic Trainer*. The Section made revisions to the document. Brian Hartz will communicate the Section's proposed changes to OATA. The Section discussed that this document should also clarify that athletic trainers are legally permitted to handle some issues with concussion management without the physician being present.
